







Short presentation of Business Development and Service Centre in the Municipality of Norddjurs

The Government's globalisation strategy:

- Currently only just under 5 per cent of Danish entrepreneurs experience solid growth
- The government has therefore formulated a strategy to create more growth entrepreneurs
- A central element in the government's strategy is enhanced cooperation between the state, regions and municipalities, including the setting up of five business development centre, one in each region



 In Denmark, companies can benefit from an easy plug 'n play registration and be ready to do business within a few hours. Establishing a business in Denmark is both cost- and tax efficient.

Key advantages when setting up a business in Denmark:


- Quick, informal and cost-efficient establishment procedures
- Online registration of new companies means you're ready to do business within a few hours
- No notarial deeds
- Danish company law is in conformity with current EU legislation




- On-line registration: A new company can be incorporated and ready to operate within a few hours by using the on-line electronic registration system provided by the <u>Danish Commerce and</u> <u>Companies Agency</u>.
- <u>Paper registration</u>: A traditional paper registration of the company may still be used but registration will usually take two to three weeks.
